

## BY ROAD

If you have a Sat Nav GPS, then entering postcode SO51 8GW brings you to our offices. The entrance and parking are at the rear of the building.

To park: Drive through the first archway (first right after the pedestrian crossing – see photo) and park on the first block of inside spaces numbered 1 to 8. NB. The second archway is for exiting traffic only, and vehicle height is restricted to 2.1m.

If your vehicle is over 2.1m there is a public car park just 50 metres' away from our offices (Sat Nav postcode SO51 8GZ). Our offices are on a one-way system, which is best avoided by heading for this car park straight away.

The public car park entrance and exit are both on Newton Lane. On leaving your vehicle head for the car park exit and turn left. Then follow the paved alleyway, using the pelican crossing to cross the road to our offices directly opposite. Please use the entrance at the rear of the building.

### A27 from south

The A27 brings you past 'Romsey Rapids' leisure centre to a roundabout. Turn left toward Ringwood, onto the Romsey Bypass Road and to the mini-roundabout at the entrance to the Broadlands estate. Turn right at the roundabout towards the town, and follow the road for 250m, crossing a mini-roundabout. There is a sharp bend to the right and a pelican crossing. Our building is next on the right.

### A27 from west

The A27 brings you along the Romsey Bypass Road to the mini-roundabout at the entrance to Broadlands estate. Turn left at the roundabout towards the town, and follow the road for 250m, crossing a mini-roundabout. There is a sharp bend to the right and a pelican crossing. Our building is next on the right.

### A3057 from north

Follow road signs for Town Centre and All Routes. Turn left under the railway bridge along Duttons Road, and then left again after 100 metres into Malmesbury Road. At the second set of traffic lights turn right to the Town Centre and follow the road past the Police Station on the left. Turn right at the next junction and follow the road for 200m crossing a mini-roundabout. There is a sharp bend to the right and a pelican crossing. Our building is next on the right.

### A3090 from east

Approaching Romsey on the A3090 continue straight ahead under 2 railway bridges, and again at the roundabout. At the traffic lights continue straight ahead following the road past the Police Station on the left. Turn right at the next junction and follow the road for 200m crossing a mini-roundabout. There is a sharp bend to the right and a pelican crossing. Our building is next on the right.

## BY RAIL

There are 3 stations serving the town: Romsey, Winchester, and Southampton. The taxi fare from either of the latter stations is approximately £15.

### Walking directions from Romsey station

Allow 5 to 10 minutes by foot. Leave the station and cross the road at the pedestrian crossing. Continue ahead down Station Road following the road until it joins The Hundred. The Phoenix pub is on your right-hand side. Turn right, and after 100 metres bear left at Boots Chemist along the Corn Market cobbled street. At the end turn left onto Bell Street and follow the road down.

Our offices are the last building on the left-hand side before the pelican crossing. Entrance is at the rear of the building.
